

J. Clarence Karcher Scholarship Application

The **J. Clarence Karcher Scholarships** honor the late Dr. J. Clarence Karcher, a 1916 graduate of the Department of Physics and Astronomy and the inventor of reflection seismography. The scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit as evidenced by grades and achievement test scores. The scholarship is \$1400 per academic year (\$700 if the student has a general university-administered academic scholarship in the amount of \$1000 or more) and may be renewed, upon application, through the fourth year of study of **physics, astronomy, astrophysics, or engineering physics** for a maximum of 8 semesters providing a high level of academic performance is maintained. The application should be submitted (or postmarked) by **March 15th** to be considered for a scholarship for the next academic year.
