2. Archibald C. ³Arch² SMITH. [2] Born on 15 Oct 1804. Archibald C. ³Arch² died in Stanly Co, NC on 28 Oct 1872; he was 68. Buried in Old Bell Cemetery. [3]

possible owner of Marks House in Albermale, Stanly Co.

Smith, uncle of Robert Nash and owner of Marks House, was a constable in Stanly Co during Civil War.

Possibly came to NC in 1877 from Ripley, TN ???

Archibald C. ³Arch² married Elizabeth PENNINGTON. Elizabeth died in 1879 in Stanly Co, NC. [4] Buried in Old Bell Cemetery.

In 1860 his estate was valued at \$1600 and his farm at \$700. During the war years he traded briefly in land, acquiring a homestead of some 280 acres ³near Mountain Creek.² Nash sold this land on December 17, 1868, and he and his family left Stanly Co, settling eventually in Statesville. [7]

In 1860 Robert S. Nash lived in Albermarle Dist of Stanly Co (as did his bother Albert F.). Robert (23) lived with wife Eliza F. (18). He valued his real estate at 700 and personal property at 900. According to census they did not marry the previous year so married 1858 or sooner. [8]

The records indicate that Nash did not own any other property during the period he owned the Marks House in Albermarle, Stanly Co. Since his sale of the property concurs with his acquisition of the 280 acres near Mountain Creek, it is plausible that Nash and his wife briefly occupied the house. They could have even rented it from his uncle ? Smith. Robert Nash sold the house and property on 29 June 1863 for \$650 to Dr. Richard Anderson, one of the most prominent citizens of the county. 7. Rev. Albert Fletcher NASH. [15] Born on 26 Jan 1828 in Stanly Co, NC. Albert Fletcher died in San Augustine Co, TX on 28 Aug 1893; he was 65. Buried in Nash Cemetery. 4 miles east of San Augustine on Griffis farm. Occupation: farmer, part owner gold mine, family legend that he was a circuit riding Methodist preacher. Religion: Methodist.

In 1850 he was 22, single and living in Rowan County, boarding with other men and working as a laborer. [16]

In 1860 Albert (32) , married to Onea (32), lived in Albermarle Dist, Stanly Co, where he farmed on land he valued at \$800 with personal property valued at \$480. Also in the household were John F. (8), Nancy (6), Henry (5), Lenora (4), and Walter R. (2) (No Nancy, census error. William Clarkston was second child) [17]

[28]Mary Ann had been in ill health. She and a neighbor had a running feud for years and the neighbor decided it was time to make amends. She went to Mary Ann to suggest they bury the hatchet. Mary Ann said, ³If I die everything is forgiven. If I live, nothing changes.²

On 10 Oct 1874 when Mary Ann ³Mittie² was 21, she married Robert Franklin TYSON, son of John Oswell TYSON (5 Jan 1809-19 Feb 1885) & Mary Hart ³Polly² SASSER (1810-31 Jan 1885), in Norwood, Stanly Co, NC. 16. Judge John Franklin NASH. Born on 4 Sep 1851 in Gold Hill, Stanly Co, NC. John Franklin died in Palestine, Anderson Co TX on 23 Feb 1933; he was 81. [32] Buried in East Hill Cemetery, Palestine. Occupation: truck farmer; politics. Religion: Methodist, one of the founders of Grace Methodist Church.

Left NC at age 19 with his father, siblings, and others in 1871. [33]
John & his family ³stopped² over at Appleton, in Shelby Co, TX where he married Amanda Burk. [34]
The family settled in Anderson Co in 1878 [35]
1890 Anderson County Tax Rolls (resident owner renditions) J.F. Nash
He had a place on Cook Street. Teetotaler and heavy Methodist. [36] County Commissioner for six years. Justice of the Peace for two years.
Died at home of daughter Byrdie Tompkins

In 1930 living with wife at 1019 Covert [37]

1881, J.F. Nash 2 horses, 20 mules; 1884, , 1885 land valuation; 116, 2 carriages/wgons, 2 horses, 13 cows, 1997; 1888; 1889 [38]

In 1900 John F (48) and Amanda (46) were living in Anderson County, where he farmed and owned his own home he owned. Children at home were Laura (18), Byrdie (14), John Henry (11), Studie M. (9), Lela (6) and Eddie Helen (4) [39]

W.C. Nash first shows up in 1876 San Augustine Tax rolls where he owns 50 acres originally owned by E. Roberts. Value that year was \$300; In 1877 land value was \$150; 1878, land valued at \$100; 1879, W.C. Nash had 100 acres valued at \$225; in 1880 \$100 acres valued at \$200, 106 acres, valued \$258; 1882, 100 acres, valued \$200; 1883, 106 acres, valued \$225; - 1887 [21]

n 1921 , Rosa S. Nash (wid. W. Clark) resided at 616 Browder in Dallas [47]

On 4 Nov 1874 when William Clarkston ³Clark² was 21, he married Rosa St. Claire WILSON [44], daughter of Samuel WILSON (17 Jan 1811-28 Nov 1886) & Cornelia MCLAURINE (5 Aug 1821-1891), in San Augustine, San Augustine Co. Born on 20 Apr 1855 in San Augustine Co, TX. [48] Rosa St. Claire died in 1923; she was 67. Buried in Grove Hill Memorial Park, Dallas, Dallas County. [44]

He worked as laborer for the railroad and Ona Williams clerked in a drygood store. He stated his father was born in Germany and mother in South Carolina. [49]

In 1910 Bob (61) and Nora (53) are living on Austin Street in Palestine. He is doing job work. Still at home are their children Maud (25), Charlie (2) who is working as a bankclerk, Willy (17) working as a confection clerk, and Corry (13). None of the children were in school. [50]

In 1920, Nora (63), now widowed, was living on Palestine Avenue in Palestine in Anderson Co with her daughter Maud(33) and son Corrie (27) [51]

In her application for a Confederate pension, Nora states she came to Texas in 1871. Died at home of son, Corrie Thresto.

1926 residence was 316 w. Green, the same as Maud Thresto, her oldest daughter [52]
