Philip L. Parker, 53, was a victim of the Sept. 11 attack on the World Trade Center in New York. He lived in Skillman.

Born in Toronto, he came to the United States in the early 1950s and became a naturalized citizen in 1963. He graduated from Tenafly High School in 1965 and received a bachelor's degree from Muhlenberg College, Allentown, Pa., in 1969.

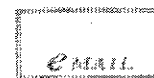
Mr. Parker was a senior vice president with AON Reinsurance Corp. in Philadelphia, but conducted much of his business from the AON offices on the 99th floor of the trade center's South Tower.

He is survived by his wife, Joan; a daughter, Stephanie; his father, Leys Parker; a sister, Leslie Bennison; two nieces, Vanessa and Dana Bennison; a brother-in-law, Bill Bennison; a sister-in-law, Kathy Zazza; his mother-in-law and father-in-law, Jean and Charles Zazza; an aunt and uncle, Margaret and Gordon Parker of Canada; and five cousins in Canada.
