Johua Joseph Parker was Born 1798, in Kentucky, According to the 1830 Census, Leake County mississippi. and the 1840 and 1850 Census Leake County, Mississippi. He is in the book titled, The History Of Leake County Mississippi. He was appointed by the Mississippi State Legislature along with these men James Prewitt, Joshua J. Parker, John M. Elder, William H. Bole, Achilles Walton, Be, and they are hereby appointed Commissioners, to organize Attalla and Leake County, Mississippi. or either of them, and full power is vested in said last name commissioners, or either of them at any time after the passage of this act, to organize said Attalla and Leake county, under the most speedy manner. These lands were aquired during the Choctaw Cession according to the treaty of Dancing Rabbit Creek. There is more to be read about him in the above mentioned book.

There is a transcribed copy of this Parker Family Bible, 1 Page copied in 1959 by the Central Texas Genealogical Society, Vol.2, No. 6 Nov. 1959. Joshua Joseph Parker b: 1798 is the last legible name that can be read. The Bible was very old and coming apart it was estimated to be about 200 years old in 1969

Joshua Joseph Parker, moved to Texas with his family about 1856, He is in the 1860 Bell County census. His sons were frontier gaurds in Comanche County, and Bell County. They were Farmers and Stock raisers, They applied for and received land grants in Bell County. You can read about his son A. Hulsey Parker in a book titled The History of Bell County, Texas. A. Hulsey Parker is also in a book titled the rise and fall of Sparta, by J.J. Bishop. A. Hulsey Parker b: 1833, At middle age he went totally blind his profession was a Cedar bucket and Cedar Keg maker, the title is a Cooper and mechanic. Some of this Parker Family is in the Parker common grave some have individual gravesites in the Pleasant Hill Cemetery, Nolanville, Bell County Texas. The ones in the common grave were relocated to Nolanville, because the land Sparta Texas was on, was to become Lake Belton, and part of Fort Hood.
