We hope this will help all of us to more fully appreciate our own blessings and family heritage. Of course, we all know that it is the gospel that makes all of this meaningful to us, and that causes us to appreciate the blessings we are all now enjoying.

It is important that we continue to make the gospel blessings available to our ancestors by furthering our Norwegian research. In the past Mother and we girls have done this over a number of years. We currently have a paid professional Norwegian researchist who is working on our Norwegian lines. She comes to us highly recommended and is very competent. It costs \$25.00 an hour to have this research done. We, therefore, need to set up a special fund for this work and would welcome contributions from any of you. We are now designating Ruth Nielsen Rich, one of Olive's daughters, as our coordinator of this research fund and the temple work.

Our researchist will do the Norwegian research and provided the name cards on our lines and we family members will do the temple work. The current temple procedure provides for the family to maintain their own line of research and temple work to be done. Ruth would, therefore, have the temple cards so that family members could request cards from her and do the temple work in their own local temples. The cards would, of course, then need to be returned to Ruth, for proper handling and recording. Ruth's address is:
